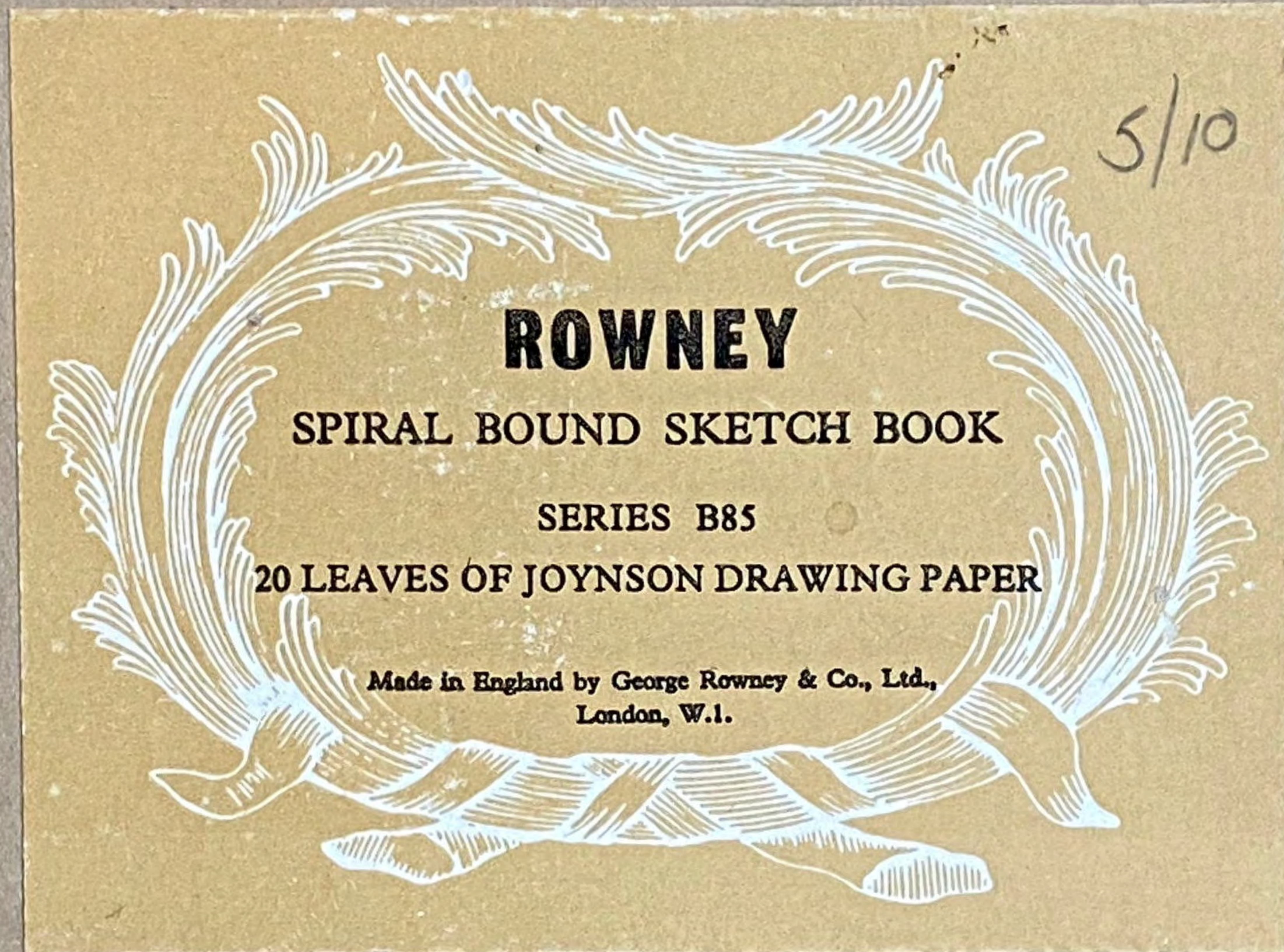


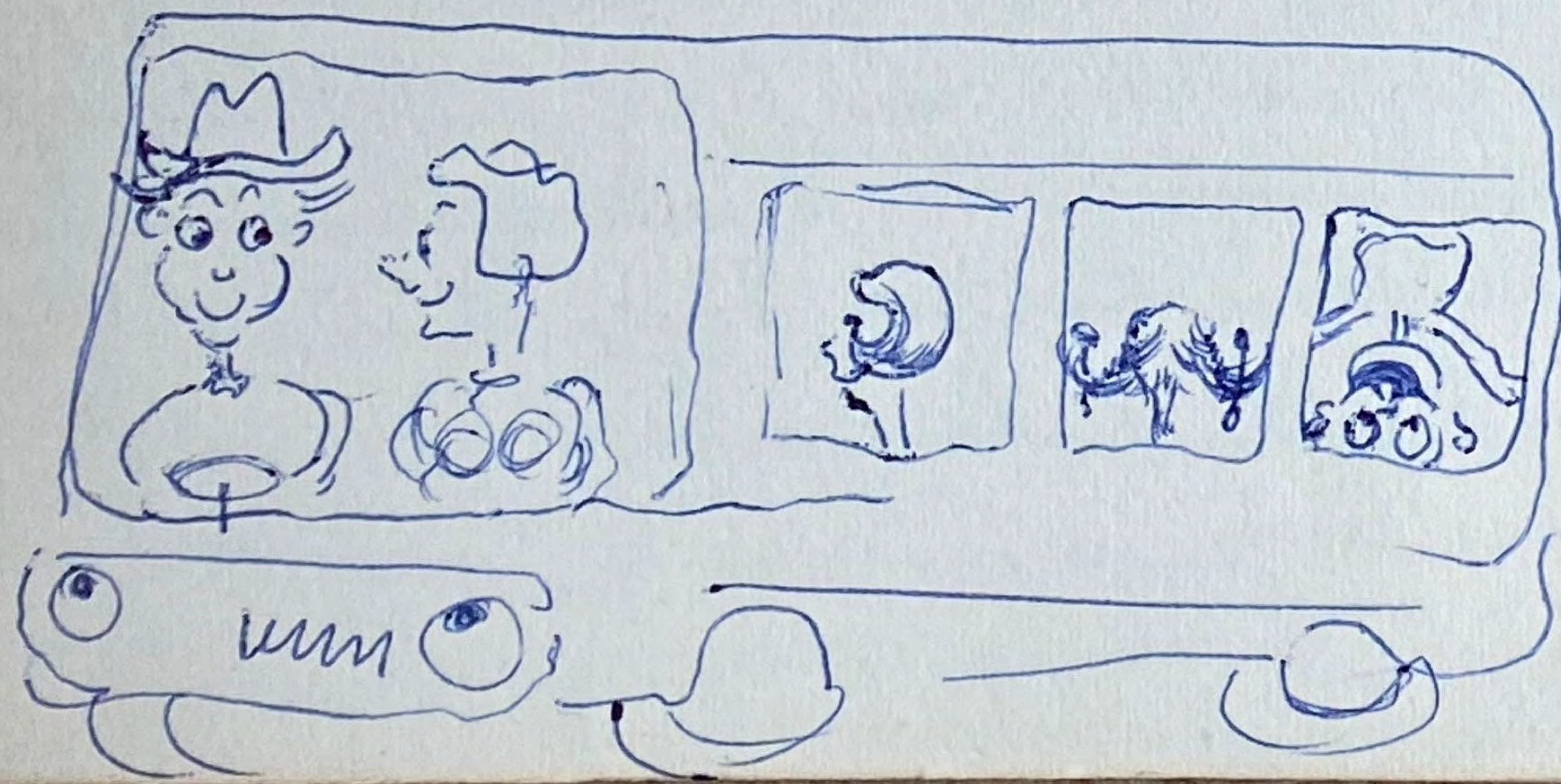
Set off after many false starts at 10.30 am.

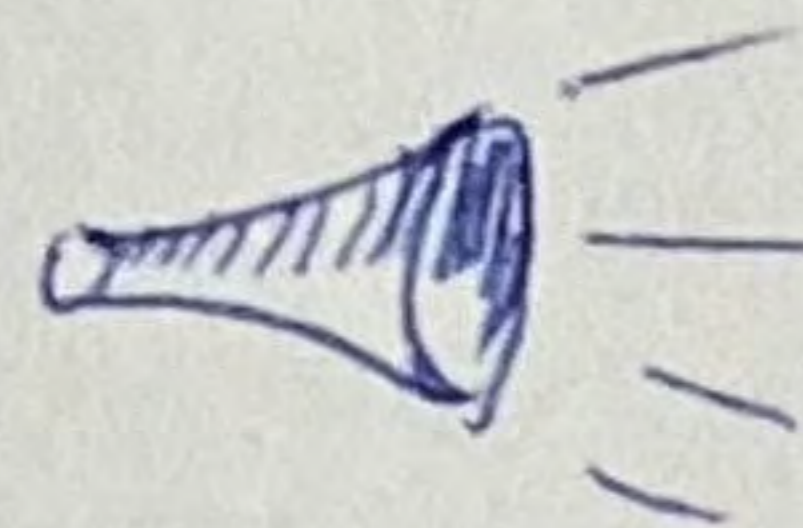
match sticks holding switch in place

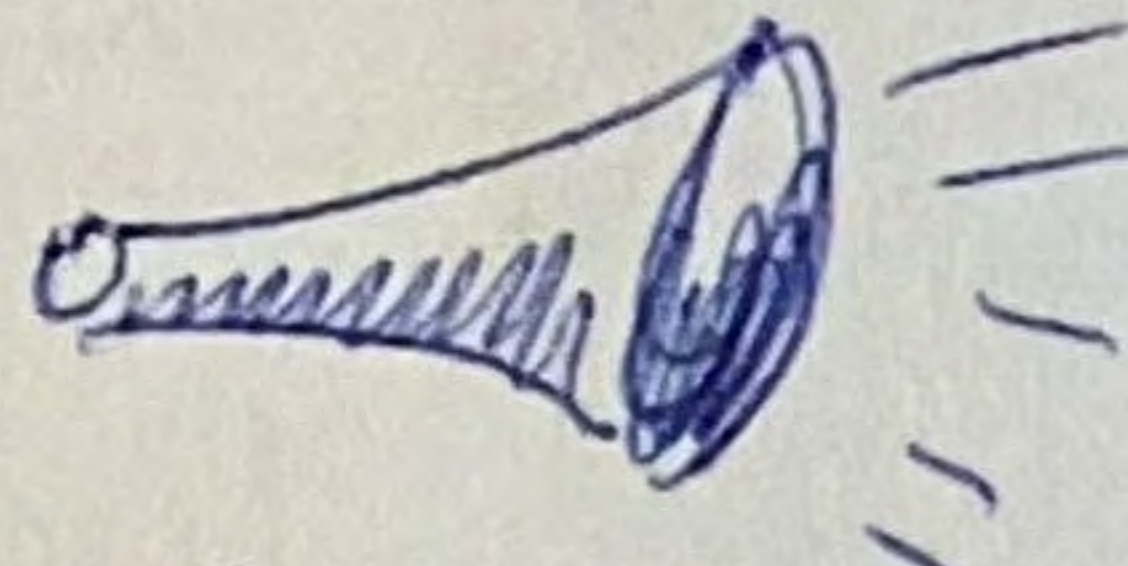
THURSDAY. 23 August. Sunshine at first then dull but bright at times. dry.

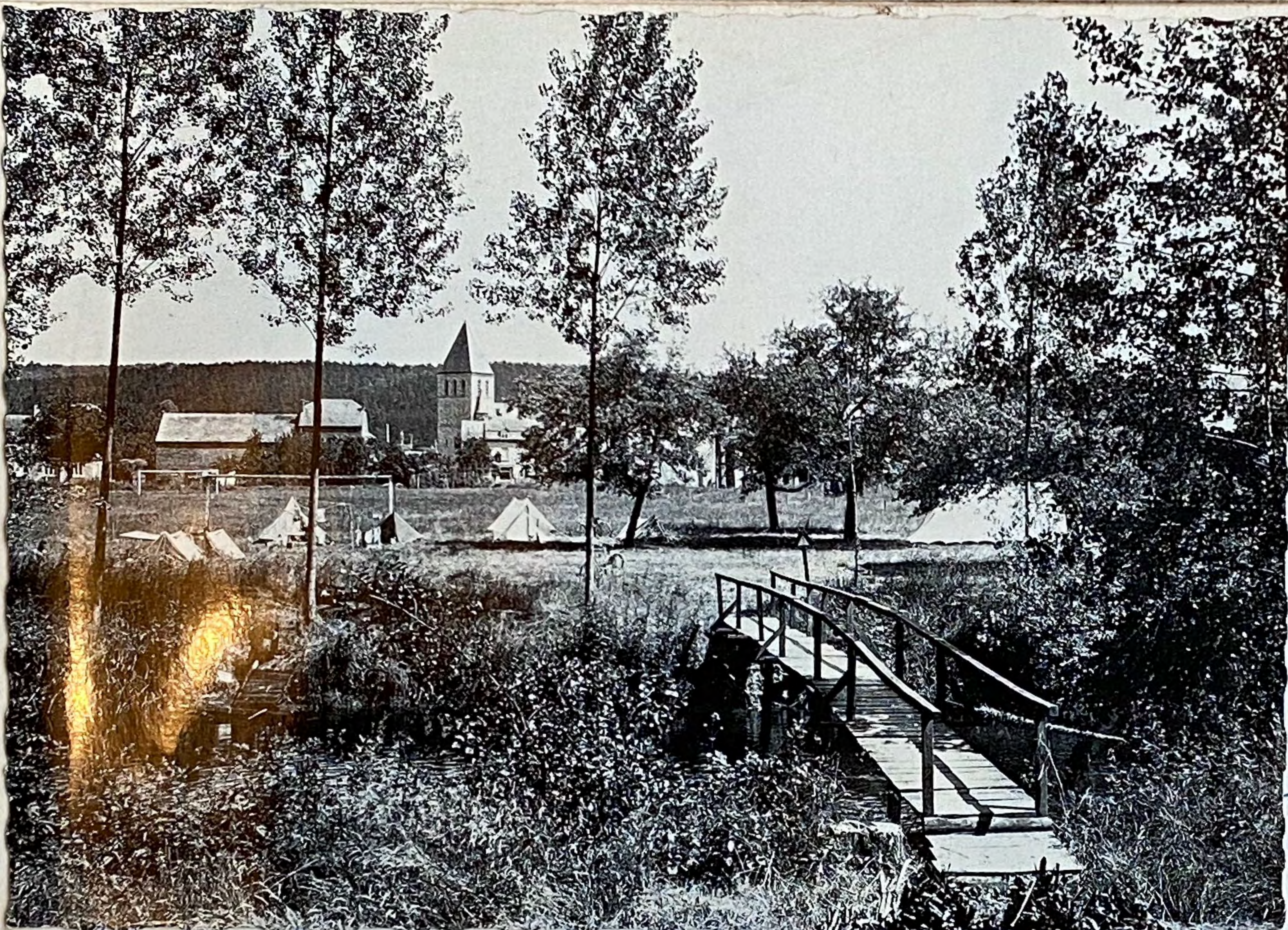
THURSDAY

FRIDAY, 24.8.62

Started to rain during breakfast. Downpour. Tacked tent during lull. Booked for caves in square. 2 mile tram (= 3 carriages) diesel. steep ascent through woods view of winding course of R. Moselle. 1/2 mile steep descent through woods. Guide speaking all languages. then 2 hour walk thro' caves. about 2 miles. indescribable. 2 huge caves - one at centre point with all sorts of stalactites. Another large cave = river Styx. Cafe - coffee & cakes. + man running down = torch. further along entered boats bats. - CANNON - ECHO.

Walked back to lunch in Restaurant.
Some had trout. Jill had chicken broth & pork cutlet. Still raining. Handle came off.
Drove on through west of Ardennes. Aulon. Neufchateau to Luxembourg. still raining
Royal Palace. + Cathedral + View of village + old citadel. Indulating picturesque wooded road to Moselle. Good campsites along Moselle but not camping weather. Arrived Trier in the dark. drove round to find Pension by Porta Nigra. - 2 comfortable rooms. Had dinner previously picnic in ploughed land. Saw hare. !! - 10 to bed.



Saturday 25.8.62

Day of gloom. Midday had broken lampshade. Alison wet bed & broke key in bedside table. Climate of hostess changed when damage announced. Heavy furniture in typical German Victorian type interior. — 2 good family portraits. Walk in sunshine. Porta Miqua. Red house in square. Beautiful fountains. Market. Oldest

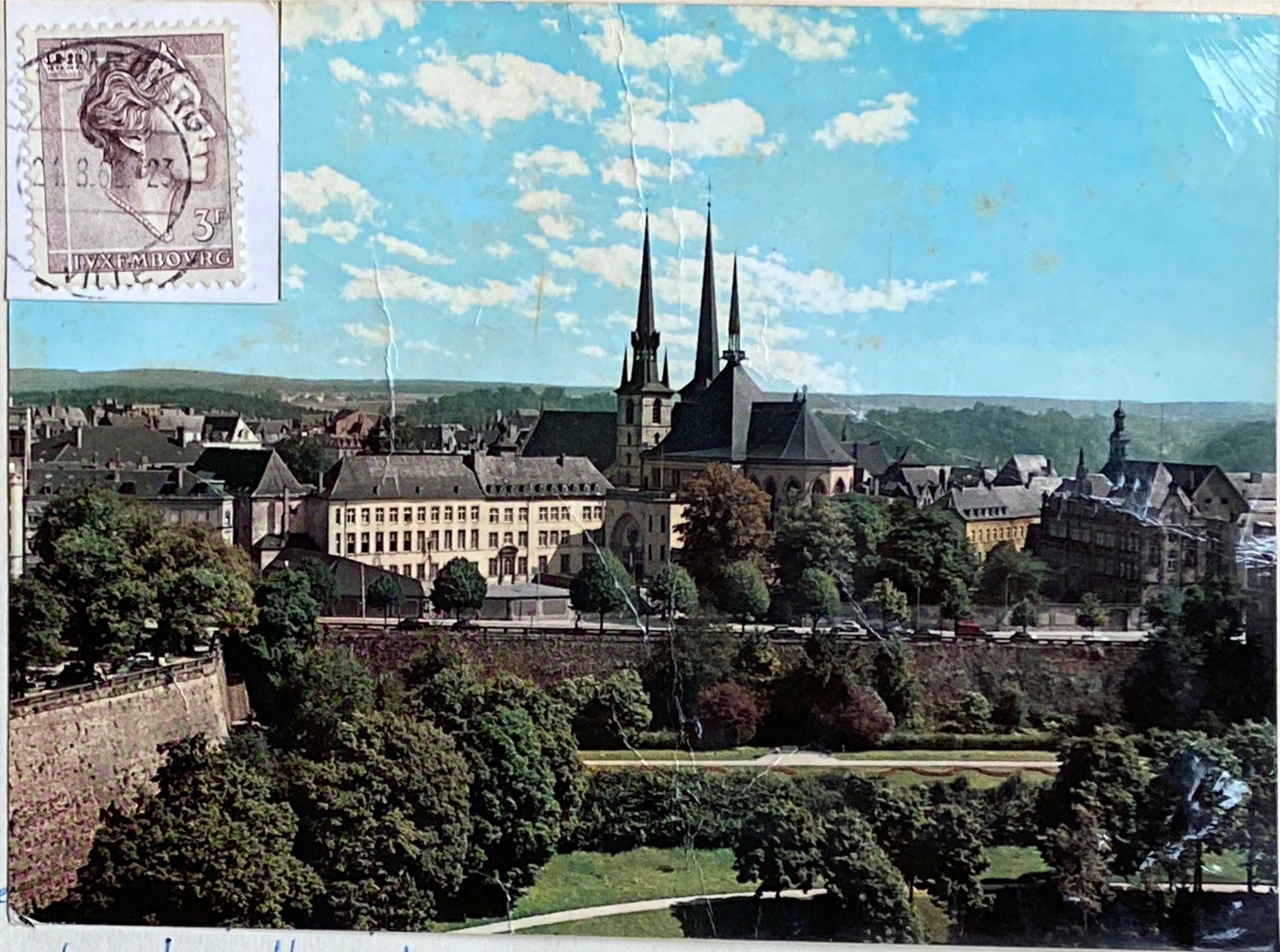
Cloister of by Porta Miqua — now a cathedral in Germany (6-11th interior spoilt c 19. rococo. baroque. Huge Basilica now nonconformist church. Modern beautiful interior, bronze font & candle sticks. — pulpit. — christening. Gardens & fountains & agapanthus in tubs Roman baths ** — maze of ? hippocasts. Town walls. Changed money — paid. Drive down Moselle. Dull weather. beautiful wine villages 120 miles of hillsides. covered in vines. Bernkastel. Hot sun. Picturesque houses in town square. Drink of Bernkastel wine in old winepress room on river front. lunch in ~~vineyard~~ vineyard a few km. away.

Rest of day, spent during dawn
Moselle. Stein fishing boats. Vineyards
castles some in ruins on hillside. & timbered
small towns.

We liked Cochen. gay town & carnival
air. ? because. Saturday night. Good
campsites but decided to go past Koblenz.
a large industrial town which we skirted.
& drove out to unmentioned but ~~xxxx~~
campsite on edge of Rhine just short of
Boppard. Rhine steamers. powered barges
tugs & barges. trains both sides of Rhine.
Sailing boats on Moselle Water skiing. meal not worth mentioning.

Sunday. 26.8.62.

Glorious sunshine, hot. Heavy mist traffic. Drove past Rhine Castles.
Cat. Mouse } to Lorelei Rock where morning beer. cocoa. coca cola. rapid currents. Vineyards
Rival Brothers. } on opposite bank. castle in middle of river. Bacharach we liked &
would have stayed. Pilot boat catching Rhine steamers. Dutch. Swiss. French.
Cerman. River opened out at Bingen into level alluvial plain full of vineyards. ^{goparagus}
fruit trees & soft fruits of all sorts. lunch in sandy acacia grove where the self started
packed up. !. lead to trunk car. Drove round Mainz. Cathedral. Rhine bridges.





Auto bahn. pleasant drive except for traffic to Heidelberg. Nice little university town. bridge (recently rebuilt) crossed over - ice cream. hot sun. university church not remarkable. lovely old streets beer cellars & good shops. Secondhand shops - beer mugs. etc. &. So to Karlsruhe - skirted the town via Ettlingen to Hennenalb - beautiful Black Forest scenery. Campsite rather crowded but pleasant enough site.

Dressed up. went out to restaurant. For Trout, Miday had pork chop &. Alison had soup. quite expensive. (one Viertel Rheinwein^{only}.) Typical Schwarzwald interior: stove, cuckoo clock & so to bed. Very cold.

Monday. 27.8.62. Sunshine soon clouded over to cloudy day but distant shining sun on the plains. The Black Forest really did look black. Baden Baden - like Cheltenham but old baths area almost deserted. Hot water drink at spring. Then hochwaldstrasse. on mountain tops. - occasional viewpoints down to Rhine valley, and about 6 big hotels. - to Freudenstadt. (on the way stopped at mountain top modern chapel.) very cold. Black Forest stopped at Freudenstadt & drove through rolling farmlands. timbered villages. - cornfields to Rottweil. Corn flowers in cornfields. huge barns - old wagons. Naked ladies in fields. Rottweil nice old town church - town gates. - fountain. bought supper, changed money. German frontier almost van out of petrol but steep hill down 3 km. to Swiss frontier. tree wheeled to petrol. - Schaffhausen. - camp about 2 km. above Rheinfalls rather crowded. & narrow between cliffs & river. People swimming in torrent. Arnoldes went out to phone father. - to bed.

Tuesday. 28.8.62 Hot sunshine.
Took van to garage near camp. Austr agent found. starter motor broken. With 2 hours to wait climbed viewing scaffold to look over a new dam being built. models, diagrams etc & then on a tram to Rhine Falls. Viewed from side, below & above then close by very impressive. bought up into torrent which we did not take. Apfelstruht & beer on the terrace of the Schloss Laufen hotel. Ice cream & cake below. Tram back. Repairs cost £4.10.5

hooked round Schaffhausen. pleasant but not v. interesting town. lovely drive to
lake Constance. Untensee rather pleasanter than the Bodensee itself. Absolute calm.
beautiful camp sites, sailing boats, steamers. lunch and a swim at Romanshorn at the
swimming pool. shallow lake hot but a bit dirty. Rorschach - then inland into mountains
high exerts, - over the border to hechtenstein Vaduz. - birthday cards for Tumbie +
Sharon. Further into the valleys. - (soldiers + defence line) Maienfeld then small autobahn
thru' Maienfeld vineyards, gorges handquart mounting & finally in sinking run with
alpenglaw Klosters Dorf + Klosters Platz. a sophisticated small town with 3 expensive
hotels. (at least). Annalies stopped to meet mother then up steep track to Campsite
idyllic, side shower, one loo, 2 basins. 2 other cars torment cows & bells & goats
Dr Hirzel waiting for us. Put up tent then down to Dinner with the Hirzels.
No Soup. Cold meat dish, salad fried potatoes. Cheese. Chocolate cream, pears, nuts on
top. Williamina liqueur. Coffee sat, talked. not too long. - back to camp with tired children.

Wednesday. 29.8.62. Hot, sunny.

Met Hirzels at 9.30 at their house. Took cable car to top of mountain.
Views of huge shining fields joining up with those at Davos. Chouder, Cows. Alpine
Flowers. Saxifrage. Snow gentian, veronica & acaulis. Thistle. House like, Anemone. Campanula.



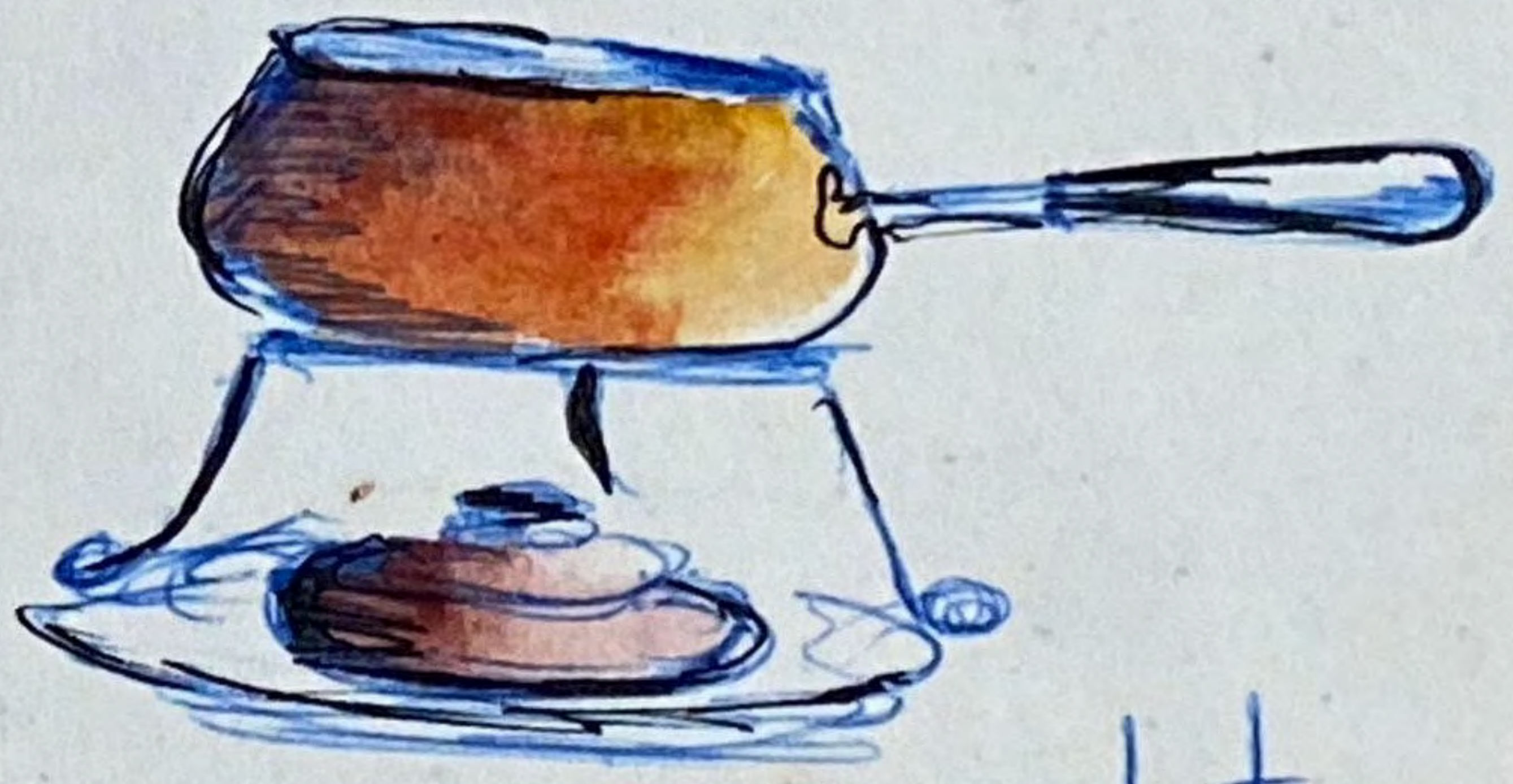

Early lunch then walk above campsite up alpine valley Pinewoods - smell - torrent - rejoined road then took high alpine valley track to Monkalp-Klosters almost up to head of valley when we saw cow & 3 men walking down track & asked about getting over to Klosters. - told there was no way over so had to retrace steps all the way back. Children v. tired. Gathered edible fungi. Supper soup. Frankfurters, sauerkraut, edible fungi in wine butter & garlic. Campfire. & Bed.

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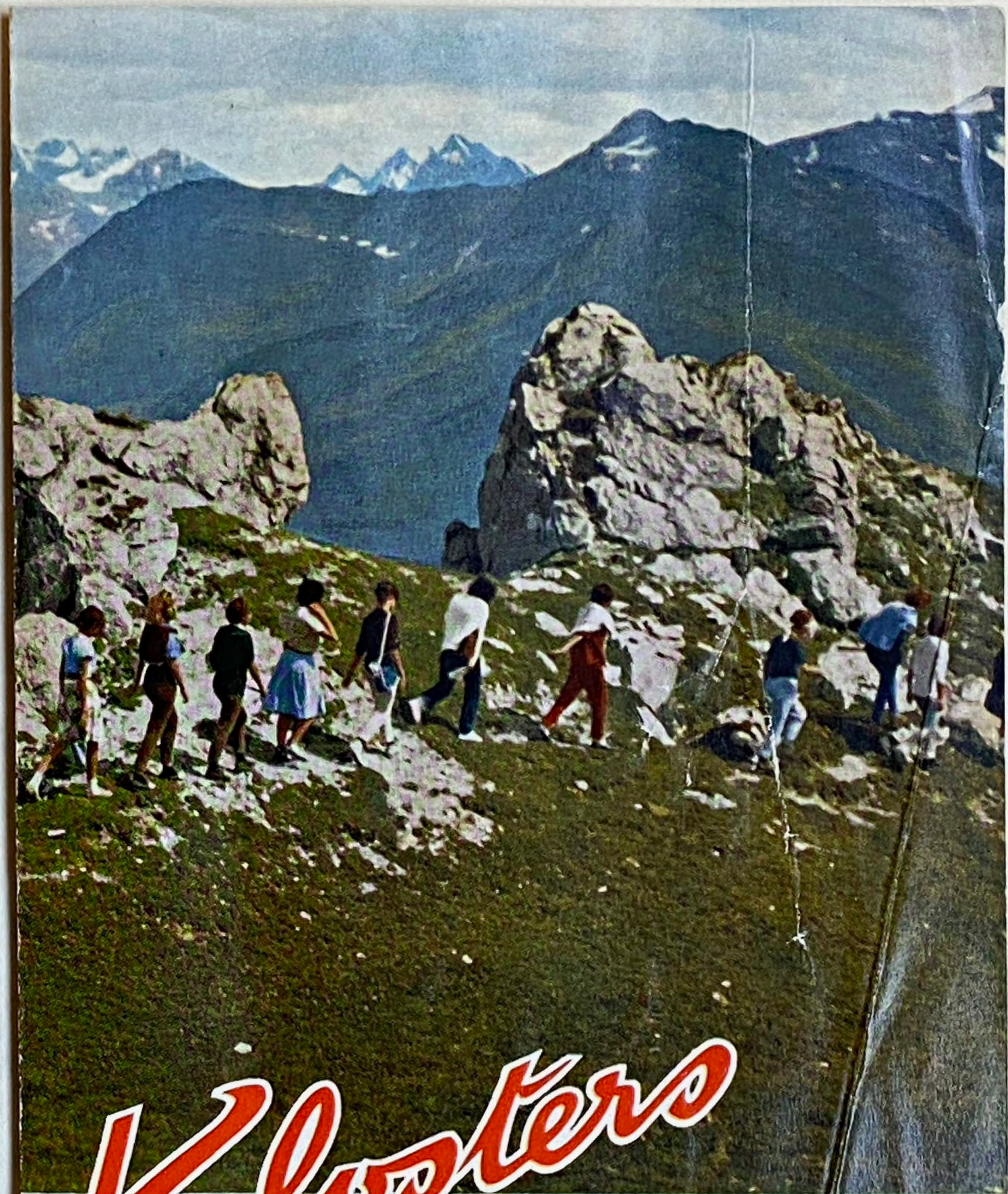


Friday 31. 8. 62

Davos campsite did not look as good as Klosters. then bleak open moor landscape, car boiled & stopped following a lorry. - walk on hillside by Jill - Alison & Mickey to collect puffballs. finally got it started? fault in petrol feed & stuck starter motor & so to top of pass, some snow - taxi & hotel. - v. steep descent

numerous hairpin bends - tourist s. lovely lunch spot in pinewoods. rocks & tourist. Cyclist from Birmingham now alone. - had done over 2,500 miles already. cooling soup by stream. Descent to Sus. Decided to see museum village at houses Engardine Guanda. high up on steep valley side slope. Truly wonderful typical Grisons windows & scraffia on walls. Cold drinks & hot chocolate at push hotel overlooking valley. Ant student. Mancunian woman on annual visit. - Descent to Susch & Zermatt, which we liked. Open pass. pinewoods. - National park. Saw nothing of note. Impressive solitude. Descent from summit, via Töchienv.

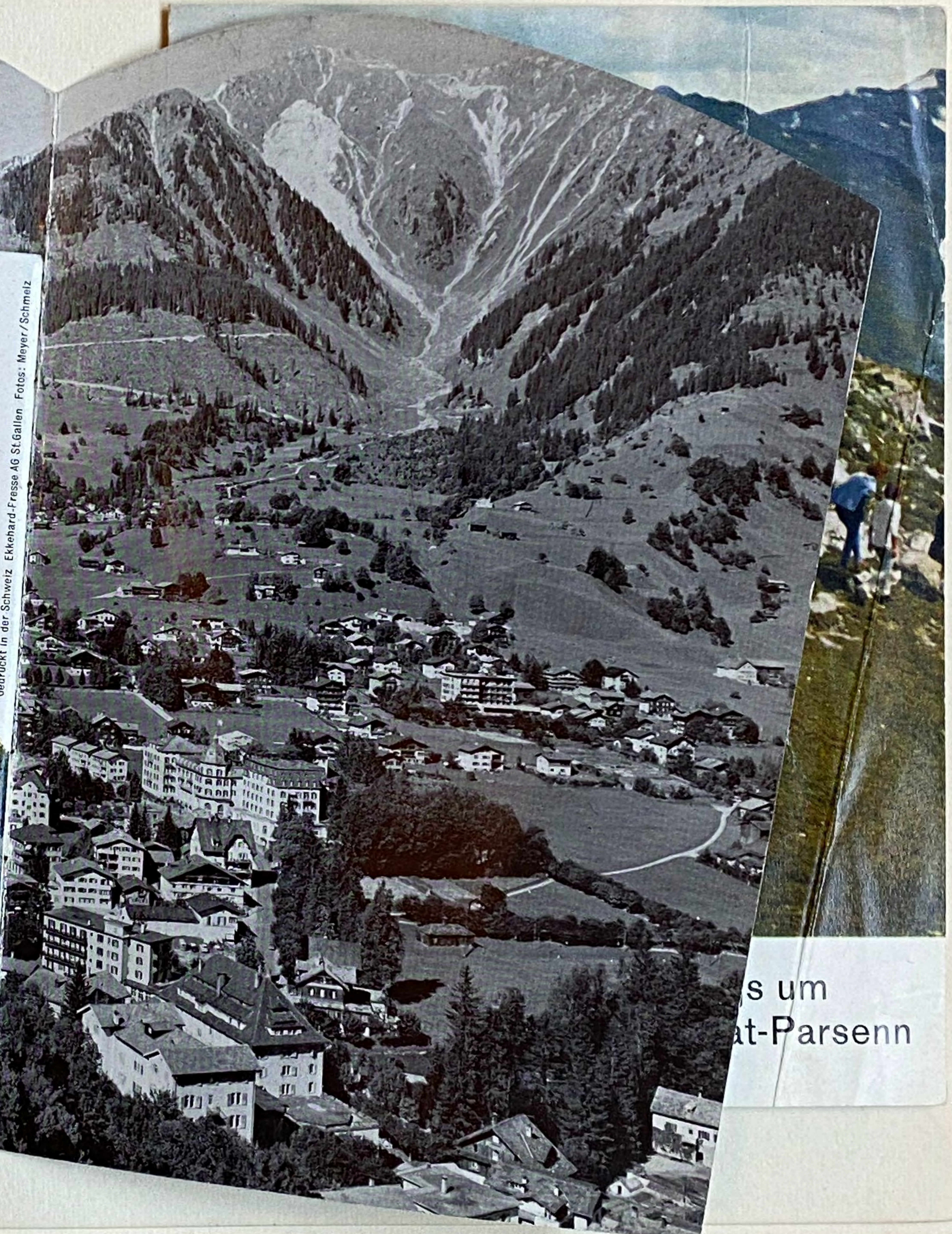

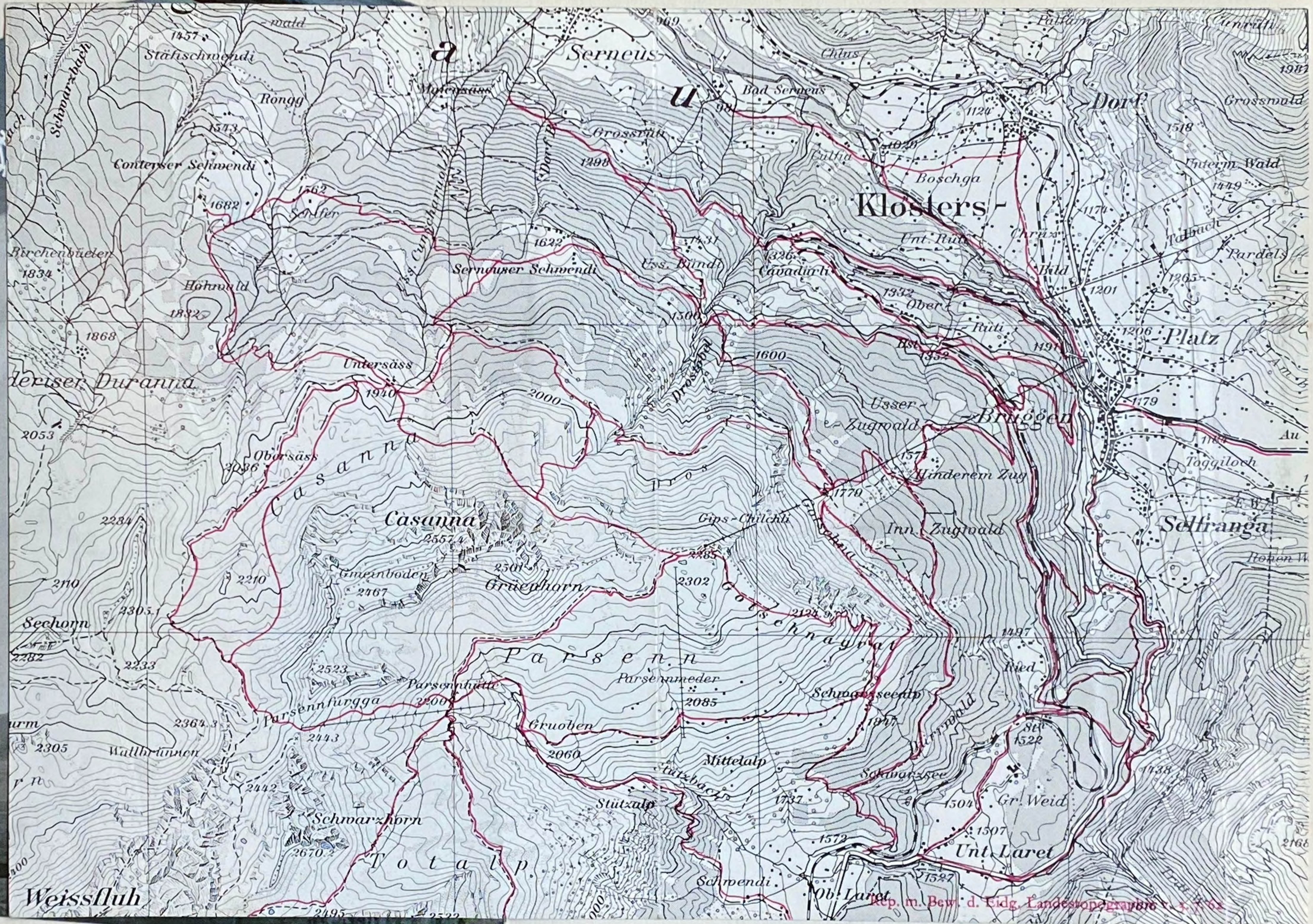



Mustair - old monastery + church with Carolingian statues + frescoes (Benedictine monastery
Abbey of St. John the Baptist. 9th frescoes. 11th bas relief. baptism. 12th statue of Charlemagne
Italian customs. Several towns we liked esp. Glöwenza, ancient walls + gate - getting
late so abandoned idea of Merano + parked in hotel backyard (newly erecting hotel
lavatories etc rather jenny built. + so to bed.

Saturday 1st. Sept.

Induced to quit early by surroundings. bought chianti

Wide open valley fruit trees, castles of robber barons?  of River Adige.
to Merano (not in centre of blossom this time.) very hot. Walk up promenade
summer to waterfall then down winter. one ice cream in shade of trees. sweet smelling
flowering shrubs. old town - lovely shops. food - fresh trout, silk shops. wood carving
shops. jewellers etc. under arched pavements. lunch, frescoes. changed money - fresh
grape juice by hand stand. + so to van. Tedious drive to Bolzano then up
wonderful. Eggenthal Gorge. Stopped at tree shaded tourist noisy restaurant for lunch
of spaghetti for Alison + soup, ~~meat~~ cutlets potatoes + salad for us. Canerza. Car boiled
+ stopped again - v. hot. Restarted + chugged up to Canerza lake - $\frac{1}{4}$ full. due to
drought. First views of Dolomites. On to summit of Costalunga then descent to (Autumn
Vigo - tempting campsite, Campitello - ditto. + so to Capazzi. Nice site by river, in pine ^{Arceus}
woods. (see pictures.) Cooked a meal (picnic only) + so to bed.



Sunday 2nd Sept. Tumbo's Birthday. Hot sunny, hazed in campsite frequent showers.

Jill did some washing. I painted. Walk round village, bought lunch etc. Picturesque chalets. Early lunch, then to chair lift up to summit of Pordoi pass in 2 stages tumbled for first 2 minutes, lovely flowers especially mountain ^{ringed} pinkies. Remarkable view from top. Sella group. Mammolata. Took foot path (which wasn't) down to Pordoi hotel then across fields to $\frac{1}{2}$ way chair lift stage. Very hot again. Dunks then decided to take foot path to Canazei, but LOST. ANTS. PANIC. STEEP DESCENT. HELL. ANTS. MORE HELL. Finally found path + so down to valley level + camp at CANAZEI. Supper after showers. English man + boy arrived. Liqueur in camp café game of football on table. + so to bed.

Monday. 3rd Sept. Hot + sunny. Deviation from set route. Off by 11. am. ascent

of Pordoi but decided to circumnavigate Sella group by Sella Pass, Gardena Pass + Campalunga Pass. Climbers at top of Sella, wonderful views, indescribable - down to Ortisei, mountain peaks. We liked v. much the Sella + Gardena passes - numerous hairpin bends. to Cortosa - good campsite we must visit again. new expanding village glorious views. Campalunga unremarkable. to Arabba. Deviation from route. Dropped off main road down unmade track. steep drop into valley of. - Gorge of ^{very} picturesque to lake at Alleghe. Formed by landslide 200 yrs ago. dropping down again to lunch



with auto on river bank. Micky fell in!! as usual, windy rather hot. Agordo we liked. **
superb gorge with some tunnels then out onto wide valley of Piave river. VERY HOT.
Vineyards sweetcorn untidy landscape, Industry. Villages. Turned off at Feltre into river
gorge in mountains again. then onto venetian plain to Treviso. Canal tour - skinted.
Distant view of mountains unhappy to leave them. Over plain by canal. ducks barges. smelly at
times. v. fertile. 1 so to Jesola. - Swing bridge 15 mile drive along sandbank spit, pines.
one or two new resorts to Punta Sabbione. - back a little way to Campo Marzio di Venezia.
Sandy poplar grove. getting dark as usual. not v. full. well appointed. Dr. Supermarket handiwerker

shops. restaurant - Macarini & so to bed.

Tuesday 4th. Sept.

VERY HOT.

After breakfast showers etc. to Punta Sabbione where boat to Venice (return for 15.000 L.)
lagoon islands big ships coming in first view of lido then main islands. I. St. Maggiore. Grand Canal.
disembarked by St. Marks. GONDOLA - GONDOLA. Bridge of Sighs. Doggies Palace. (How much is that
Dogue in the window) more impressed in details than last time. e.g. carving on Dogues palace hoggets
below campanile in portraits of past Dogues. pigeons, Jacks on clock. Tried to find our way but
kept losing way & coming back to S. Marks. improperly dressed ^(John in shorts) & so couldn't go into churches
turned out of S. Found square where pottery last time & found no pottery.
At last Rialto Bridge. Market vegetables & fish. Bought fish. lunch in restaurant indifferent
& expensive. Tortellina, Spaghetti. Mixed fried fish rather cold, milanese steak pork chop. fruit.
After this got quite lost. many alleyways. canals. and canals, back passages & fondamentos
they smelt like it. At last to S. Friani, Jill turned out (improperly dressed. bene amos.)
Cold cocco cda, revolution men arguing, cage birds singing. oleanders. vivid impressions of
back streets. Mad rush over bridge, S. Marks etc to get boat back to P. Sabbioni. all then
sank thankfully into sea, rather dull day & cool. shells on beach, hermit crabs, miles of sand,
warm sea empty beach cooked fish rather shiny not v. nice. & so to bed.

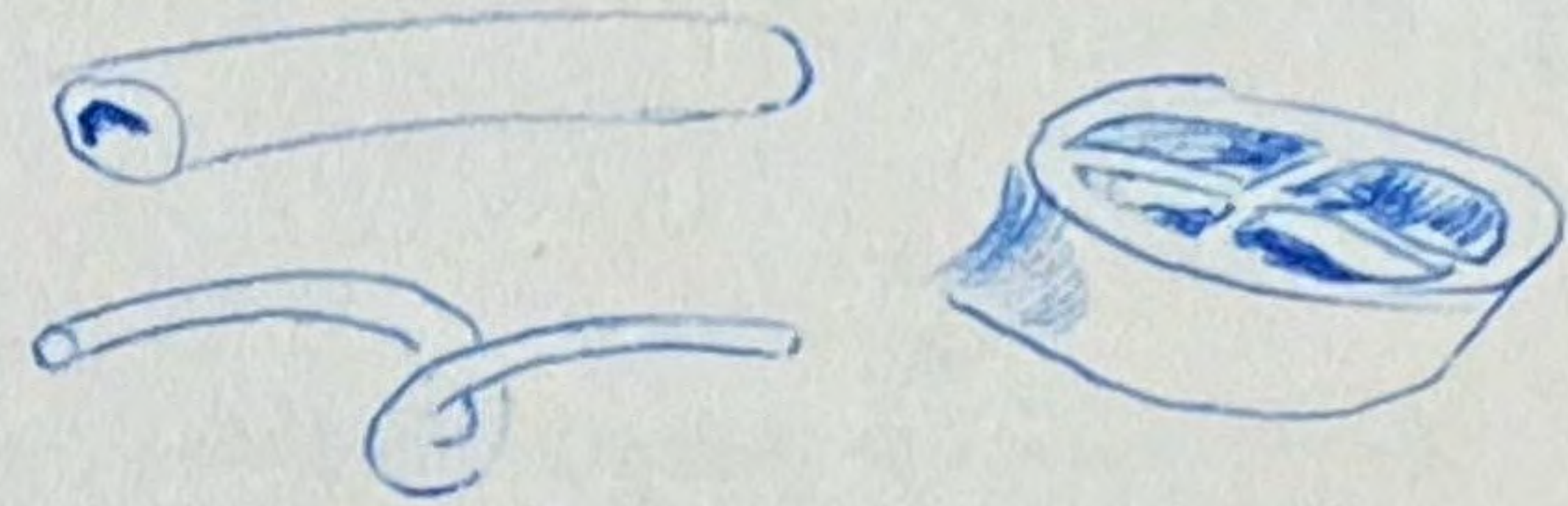
Billie. All well at home. On to bridge - Bag lost again - back to Church S. Zampolo. Found bag

Thursday 6th. Sept. VERY HOT.

Bathe. Shower. breakfast shower. - bathe again set out at 11 am. Drive back to Tesola. Venice lagoon.
pleasant big farms. fertile plain. Industry at Mestre - along canal to Stra. - 3. Palladian palaces
& mansions - homes of rich Venetians who retired there in the summer. VERY VERY HOT. - to Padua.
much nicer than we remembered. stopped in little square - ruins of Roman amphitheatre - garden
by chapel of Scrovegni. built in 1303 as part of a palace. xxx frescoes by Giotto. - scenes of
N.T. and huge last judgement. Beautiful altar piece by Pisano. hunch in square. - Drinking fountain
Solicitor & family from Bristol. then to Basilica of the Saint. Anthony of Padua. Centre of the cult.
New orphan village being erected. Tomb of Saint. - ornate. - bas reliefs. High altar bronzes by Donatello.
For other details see book. Two cloisters. Enormous relics of the saint. - tongue & jawbone etc.
Equestrian statue of Gattamelata (tubby cat) because of his agility. First bronze of this size to be
cast since Roman times. 1447. Ice cream in square. On ~~Castrostrada~~ to Vicenza. 30 miles on.
Palladian farm houses in fertile countryside. Vicenza set amongst volcanic hills. Parked by Museum.



then into Palladian theatre finished by Scamozzi, in 1583, modelled on Roman theatre.
beautiful stage with 3 streets open in perspective. First play Oedipus Rex. Rehearsal in progress

in world. Walked to river to see old castle of Scaligers and bridge. City peculiar battlements. Very
complete castle. Back to old city on other side of river. Bought lunch in old town. Little birds on
skewer, pisi & risi. smelly fish & pizza. Into Piazza della Erbe. Roman Forum - fountain &
market stalls. Venetian column & winged lion of S. Mark. → Piazza dei Signori with beautiful loggia
and other buildings. - Piazza. Mazzanti - men playing cards. Tombs of Scaligers thro' archway in
square. Church S. ^{Anastasia} ~~Antonio~~ ^{Marino} = 2. hunchbacks of Verona. & fresco of S. George delivering prisoner of
Trebizond was missing.

Saturday 8th. Sept. VERY HOT. WINDY. DUST STORM.

To Brescia. atten. swim shower. swim. Quick shift at Piazza della Loggia of which the citizens are proud. the work of Bramante, Sansovino, Palladio. Several fountains. Quite picturesque although industrial. To lake Iseo a big disappointment. E. side not too bad and villages on big island in centre probably picturesque but otherwise rather industrial. barbed wire steep banks not permitting access to lake and cornice road. An otherwise picturesque ^{lake pt.} road spoilt. lunch by lakeside - auto + r. WIND - quite big waves - too cold & rough to swim. We all felt this was a wasted afternoon, but (GALATI, CASATINA (melted)) for lunch. ice cream nuts & fruit. On to Bergamo. FAMILY REVOLUTION at seeing another town - overcome & all were glad eventually to see the glorious haute ville - the old town reached by cable car. Piazza Vecchia. - fountain, covered stairway to bell tower. White marble Scamozziano Palace (Palladian). Octagonal baptistry. Colleoni Chapel. - Amadeo designed this for Colleoni a soldier of fortune who served the Venetian republic. Frescoes by Tiepolo. Equestrian statue by a Nuremberg sculptor Church. S. Maria Maggiore Lombard porch by Amadeo. i Alexander on a horse. 4 lobed chapel of holy cross. tapestries xxx (16 some Flemish. (see p.c. overleaf.) and others Italian). Baroque confessional. 16 inlaid stalls. Down the funicular again. drive like mad to Como. in twilight. Italian, Swiss Customs. & so in dark to L. Lugano. Morcote & in some difficulty. to Campotricino camp at Figino. Supper in dark & so to bed. Steak, beans & potatoes.

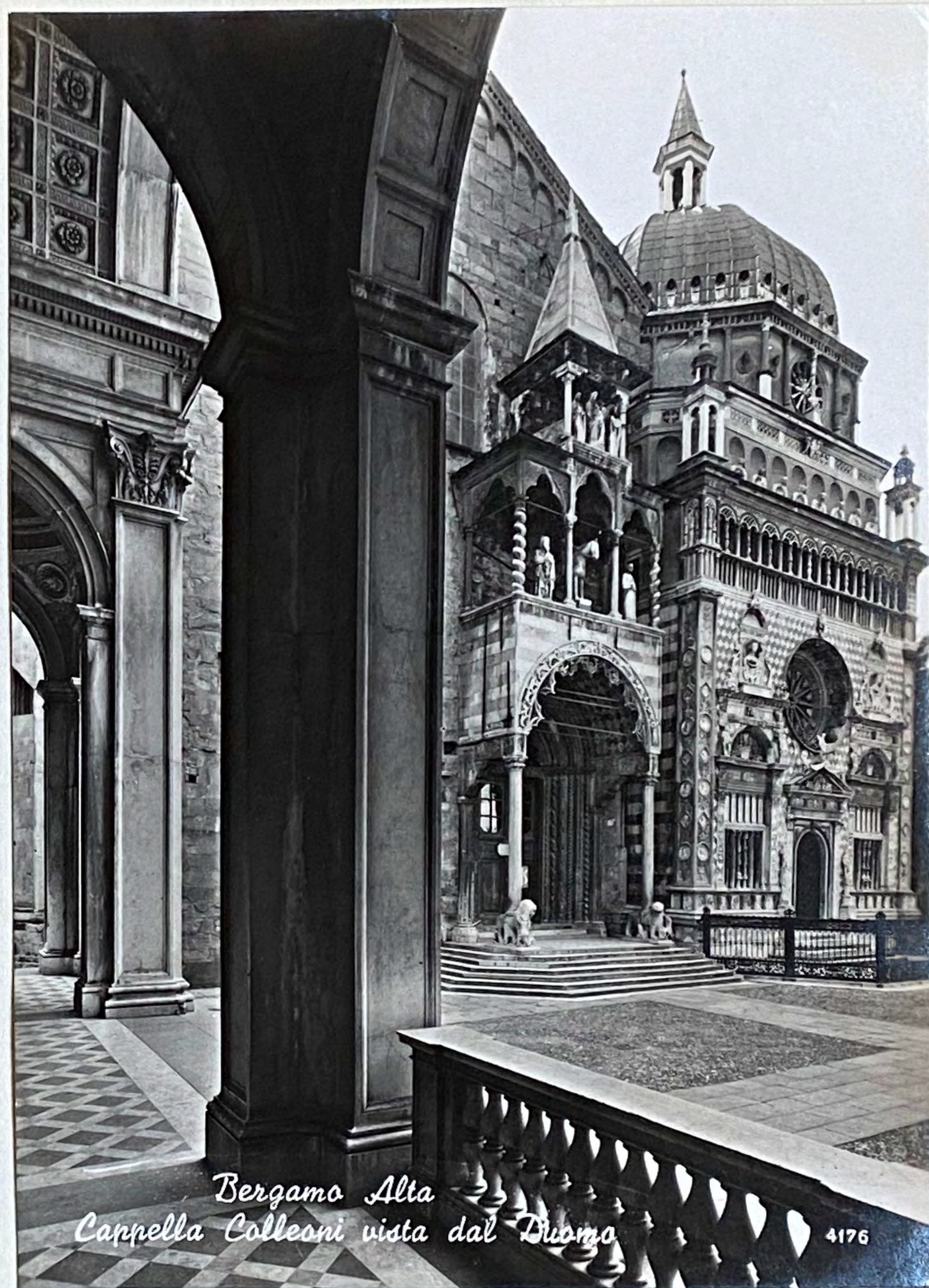
Sunday, 9th. Sept.

extensive views over lake. & to snow capped Monte Rosa. Walk down thru woods to C lovely village.
then long walk along road & hillside. then footpath down to Vico Morcote - thru vineyards
to churchyard at Morcote & thru ch. down staircase to quay. Jill left her bag
behind again. (sat down and pinched an apricot on Sunday) [just retribution] Morcote full of vicinos.
& grapes. (also pinched.) No pottery - worth a visit. expensive restaurants. Boat back to
Inzano. - saw speedboat racing at Italian Campione. At Inzano had to take Hicky
& Alison on paddle boats for $\frac{1}{2}$ hour. 41-. then tried to see Grandvia but couldn't

Breakfast in sunshine. on benches. with wasps. - Pushed up - Inzano. Bellinzona
with its 3 castles - stopped in town & bought lunch. & toy for Jumbo & Carmen D'ade.



Drove on & up & over. St. Gotthard Pass. 40 hair pin bends. engine stalled once stopped to take photo & several times to let heavy traffic get ahead. Val Tignes quite incredible. Stopped at top for lunch by bubbling stream - dam & hydroelectric. Good road down to Hospenthal with only few bends. Andernach with view of Oberalpen pass. Full of army ~~camp~~ manoeuvres. Down past Devil's bridge (missed it). & so to end of S. Gotthard tunnel & Wassen where we turned off.

to Susten Pass. decided against going to hucens. after all. Susten Pass. the best yet but stalled 3 x at least & wasted at least an hour. — once bashed into wall but finally got to tunnel at summit where incredible views down the valley. Soup & pork cutlets & chips. ^{beers apfelstr.} red wine v. good & cheap. pleasant serving girl. music. & so to bed.

Tuesday 11th. Sept. Hot & Sunny.





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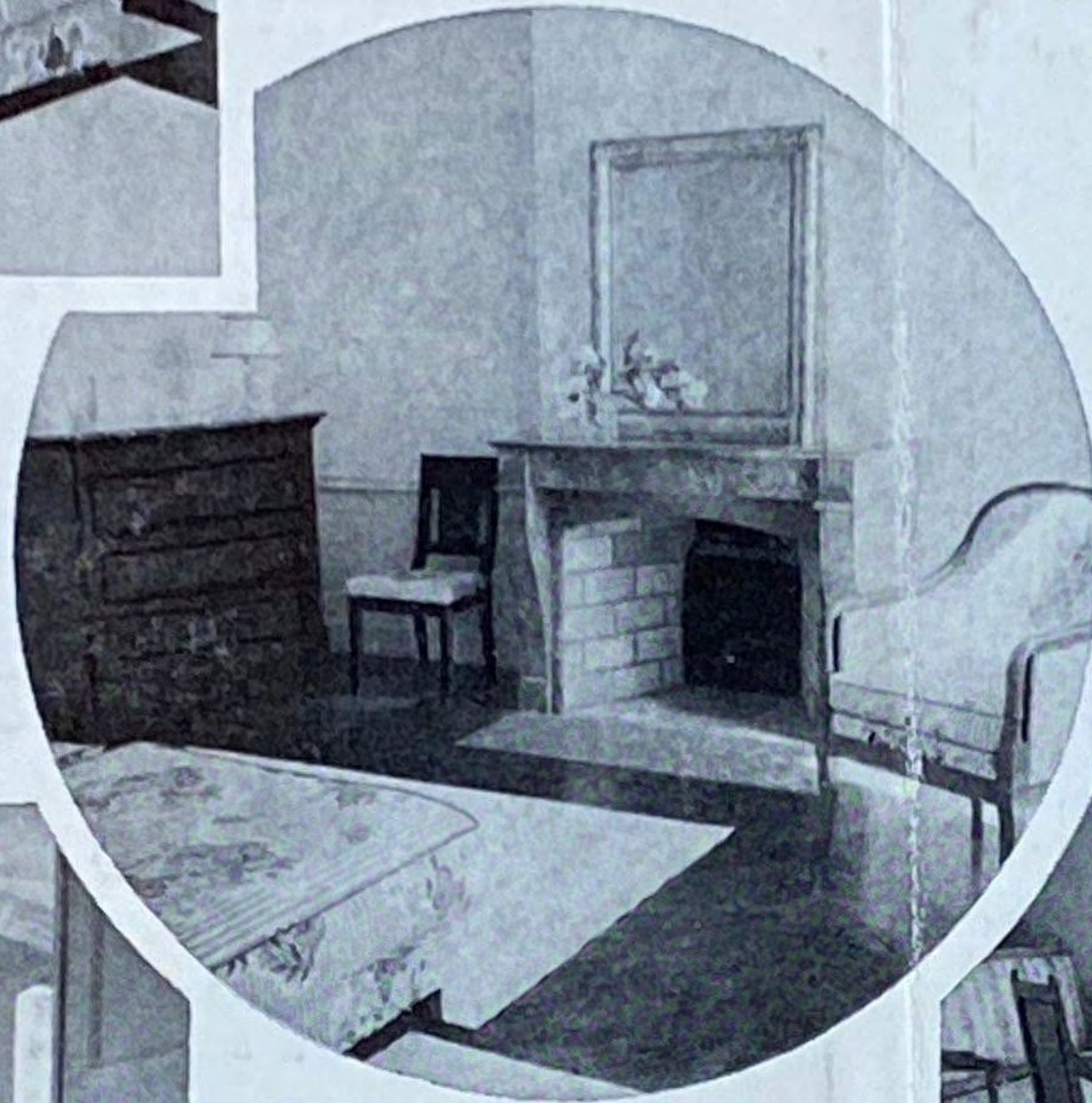
